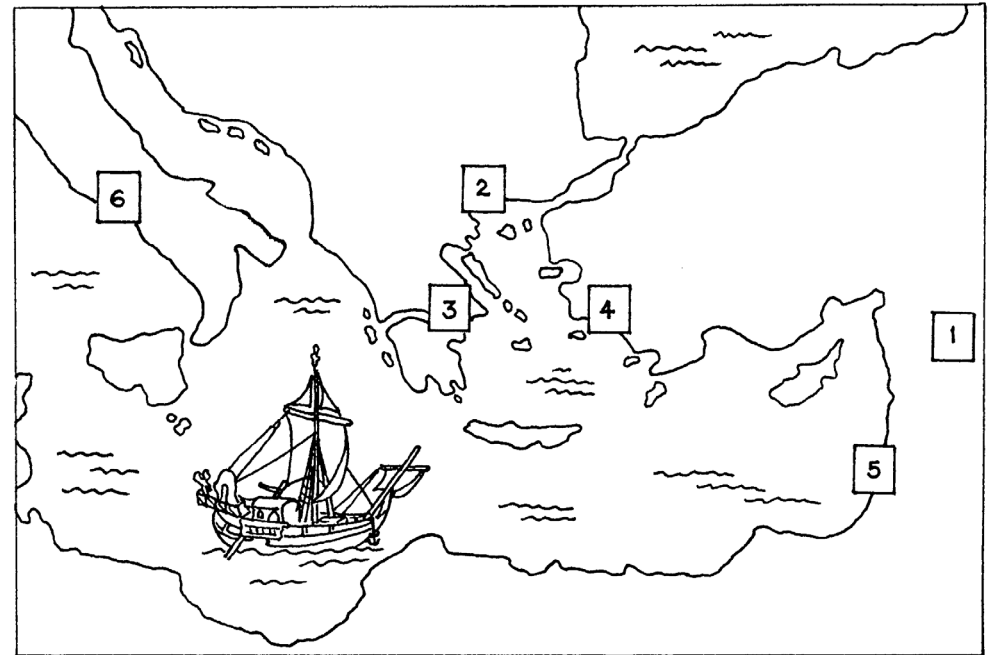

Key to map:

1 - Damascus; 2 - Philippi; 3 - Athens; 4 - Ephesus; 5 - Caesarea; 6 - Rome

Making your own display:

Children who have collected the Bible Learning Course sheet Nos 18 - 24 can make their own display of Paul's journeys by placing this map on a sheet of card and then surrounding it by the seven previous sheets. Use a piece of thread and pins, or a drawn line, to connect the numbers on the map to the correct town named on the sheets e.g. connect the sheet named DAMASCUS with 1 on the map. (Remember there were two sheets for Philippi.)
