## vernon higham was born in Caernarfon ..

Vernon Higham was born in Caernarfon, North Wales, but moved to Bolton in Lancashire, England, during the depression in the 1930's.

Following a period as a teacher in his early twenties, he attended

theological college in Aberystwyth and came to know Christ's saving power whilst there in 1953.

Vernon Higham served, in his early ministry, in Welsh speaking churches at Pontardulais from 1955 to 1958, and at Llanddewibrefi from 1958 to 1962.



There followed a call in 1962 to Heath Church in Cardiff, where he served for forty years.



In the summer of 2003 he took up the position of Pastor Emeritus in our church at Tabernacle Cardiff.

Before their marriage in 1955, Morwen Higham served as a 'Sister of the People' in the Forward Movement.

Throughout their marriage Vernon and Morwen Higham worked together as partners in the Gospel work, as heirs together of the grace of life.
