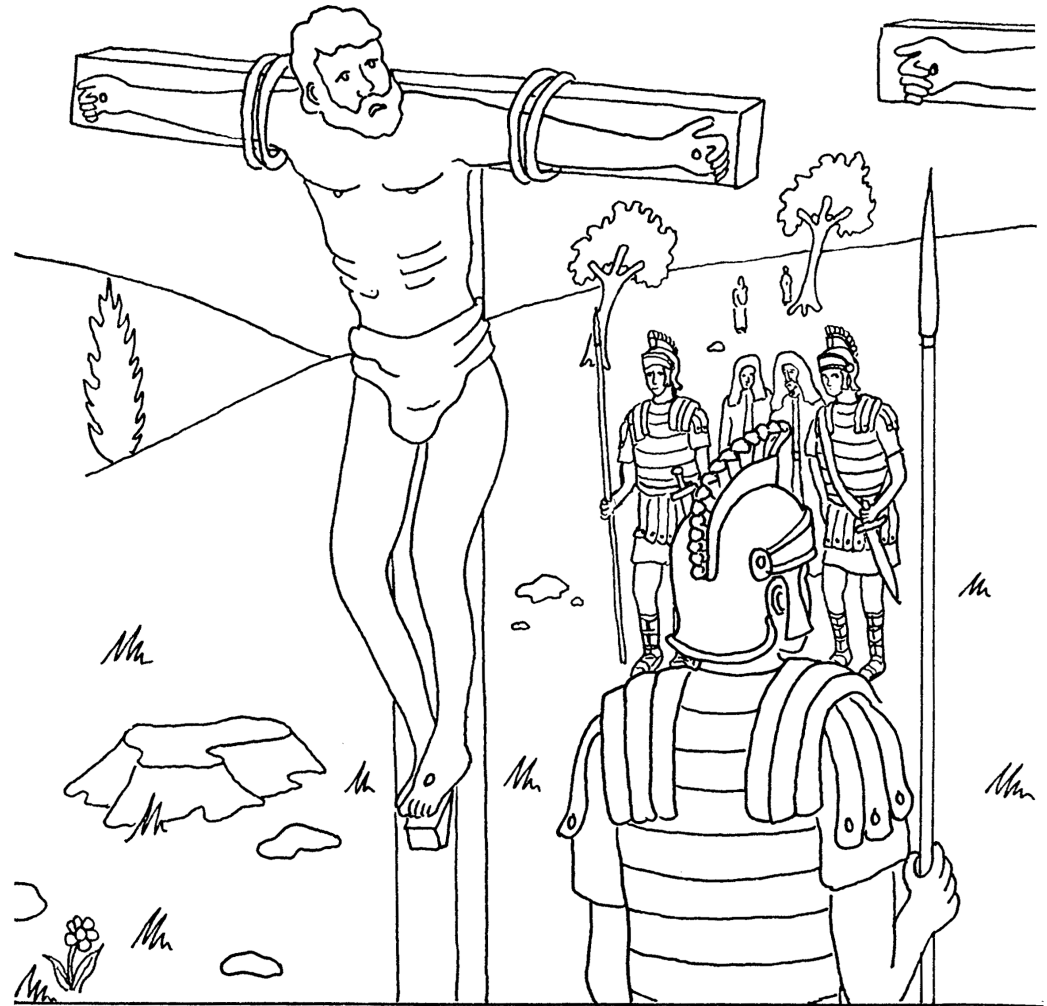
This week's hymn verse:
