4. Which river did they have to cross before they reached Canaan?

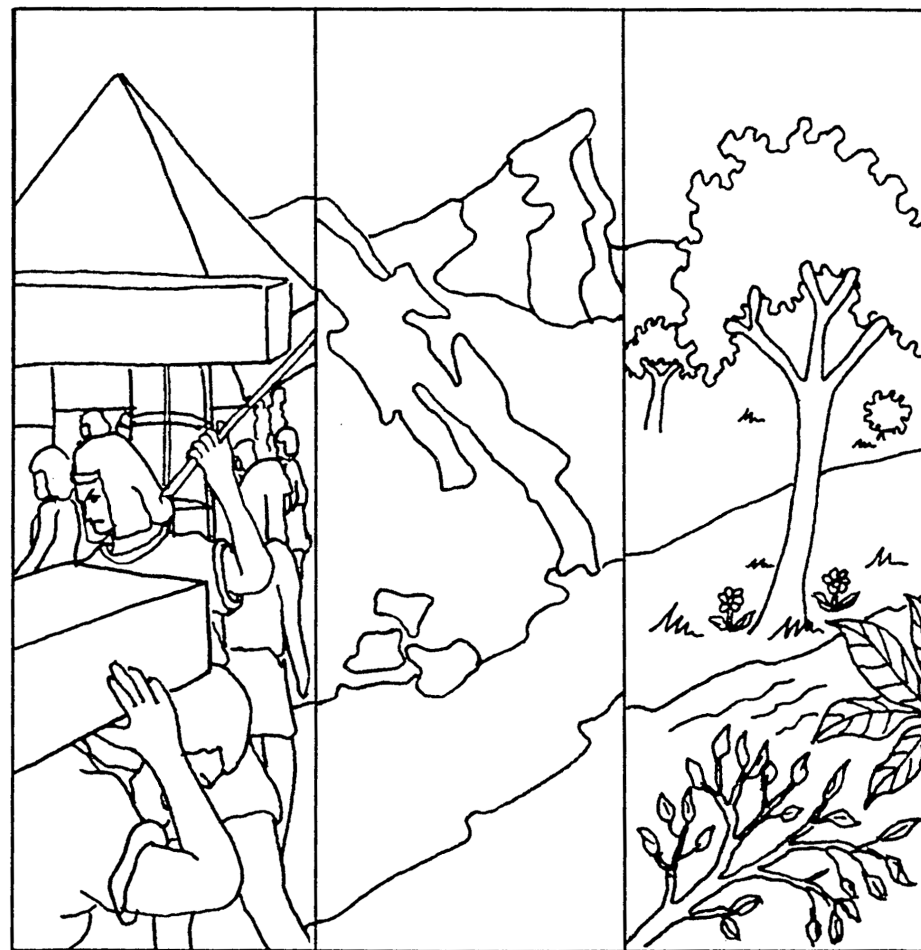
