Vernon Higham was born in Caernarfon, North Wales, but moved to Bolton in Lancashire, England, during the depression in the 1930's.

Following a period as a teacher in his early twenties, he attended theological college in Aberystwyth and came to know Christ's saving power whilst there in 1953.

His early ministry was in Welsh speaking churches at Pontardulais from 1955 to 1958 and at Llanddewi from 1958 to 1962.

There followed a call in 1962 to Heath Church Cardiff where he served for forty years.
